At Dr Kilpatrick & Partners we take our patient information as being as important as your health and there are currently different schemes either in place or being discussed by the government and in the media, they are about sharing your medical information with other systems mainly within the NHS. So that we can ensure that the correct information is recorded please tick the relevant box for the two areas below.

1. Summary Care Records – this is purely for NHS A&E, Urgent Care & Walk-In Centres and is for the clinician that you would be seeing to aid them in your treatment. They will ask you at the time if you are happy to consent or dissent for the information to be viewed or sent to the practice. **Please tick one of the three below**

I consent to my medication and any allergies being shared

I consent to my medication, allergies and any significant illnesses or diseases

I dissent to any information being released

2. Care.Data - this is currently on hold whilst the government are reviewing the scheme but as this scheme has caused a lot of controversy we are taking this opportunity to ask our patients so that we can amend your records accordingly. There are two aspects to this, 1) personal data being shared with the NHS Health & Social Care Information Centre, if you opt-in for this you can then choose the second option to opt-out of, 2) personal data being disclosed by NHS HSCIC to other organisations.
